- Deer resistant • Evergreen

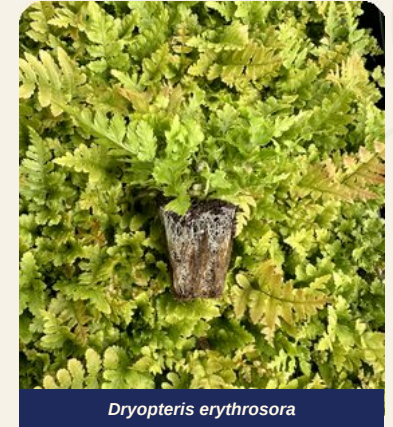

- Dramatic vase-shaped habit
- Very cold hardy • Spreads by runners

Korean Rock Fern

Z 6-9 Part-Full Shade

- Compact with intricate lacy texture
- Excellent in containers or borders



Polystichum rigens

Rigid Shield Fern

Z 5-9 Part-Full Shade

- Stiff, lustrous deep-green fronds
- Exceptional hardiness • Evergreen

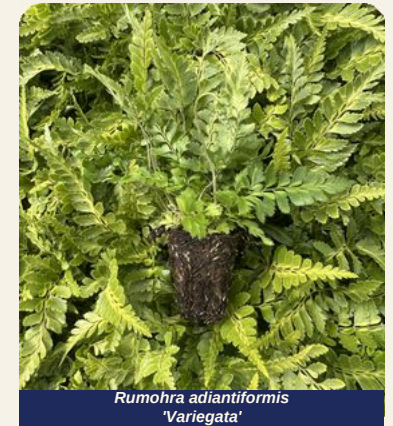


Polystichum munitum

Z 3-9 Part-Full Shade

- Bold, architectural year-round form
- Native to Pacific Northwest • Evergreen...
